Project 1 Outline

OVERVIEW

Hari was introduced on 2/2. Students spent the class watching videos that provided context and then charting the text in small groups using PACES and their own preferred marking techniques. They were reminded to view the supplementary content on BB (Rat Park, TED Talk, etc...).

- **Proposals:** Students have been told that project 1's proposal is a simplified version of what will be expected from future projects. They were asked to identify Hari's project, one of the claims they intend to analyze, a rhetorical strategy, and anything else they want to address regarding the text.
- **Paragraph Bootcamp:** In-class activity involving intense revision of a student's chosen "problem paragraph." Small groups with work together to identify, discuss, and revise each other's writing. Possible templates, word banks, etc... will be provided. Whole-class discussion will review common and requested writing struggles, questions, or concerns.
- Workshops: Mandatory peer review workshops for each project. Students will use a guide sheet that will be stapled to their final drafts. Workshop is entire class period.
- **Conferencing:** Students were asked on the first day how they wanted to handle conferencing. All students decided on optional conferencing for all but the final project. A sign-up sheet will be provided before each project for those interested. Students will also be regularly encouraged to take advantage of the Writing Center (first appointment for extra credit).
